Full Marathon Entry Fees

- \$65.00 Pre-registration to June 1, 2017
- \$75.00 June 1, 2017 to October 8, 2017

Our 13.1 mile, Half Marathon follows the same course as the Full Marathon.

The Half Marathon is an out and back course configuration with a well marked and staffed turn point.

The Half Marathon course has minimal hills and is a great way to challenge yourself with a beautiful run.

- \$65.00 June 1, 2017 to October 8, 2017
