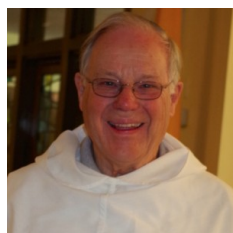
FR. MICHAEL CHAMPLIN, O.P.

He was a seminary professor and also served as preaching resource person on the faculty of the Center for Pastoral Liturgy at the University, Notre Dame. Fr Mike was born in St Paul, Minnesota in January 1939.



SR. JOAN BUKREY, O.S.F.
